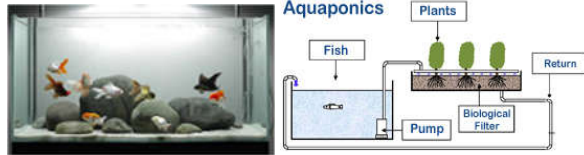
Target:

- Aqua- Management (Job aids, Water/Pond/Cage Management, feeding quality, and harvesting)



- Feed Production (Local Raw Material by protein/energy classification, Quality Mixing, production (local /automated), storage, Feeding Facilitates (local/automated)



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- Pros and Cons of the Ugandan Fish Post-harvest handling methods (fuel wood drying, sun drying, frying, solar drying)

Through the following learning activities:

- Two (2) hour field site visit and practical viewing of Aqua Activities
- 30- minute Question and Answer Session
- One (1) hour quiz /Feed Back Form completion
- Quiz results (plus awards)/Lunch/Break/End

Delivering the following outputs:

- Lecture Notes/Brochure
- Individual results of the HOPE Incubator quiz (20 Multiple Choice Questions)
- **Uganda shillings 20,000/= award** to a quiz winner, **Ug.shs 15,000/=** to the runner-up, and **Ug. shs 10,000/= to the third placed run-up**. In case of a tie of the above 3-results, the award is shared among the above three tiers-**with all above awards based on the 80% + pass mark of the individual quiz results.**

Concluding with following the final outcomes:

The short-term outcome includes the number of students/participants who have at least mastered the basics of Aquaculture by scoring at least 50 % pass mark of the field work quiz questions touching on all **HOPE Incubator** Content presented by the Theme experts, and Field work observations.
